Japanese Language and Culture Program (Privately-funded International Students)
Application Guidelines

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| Program Outline | We offer Japanese language courses from elementary “Japanese I” to advanced “Japanese VI,” matching individual level of each student, along with the courses of Japanese culture such as “calligraphy” and “flower arrangement.” Students at the advanced Japanese level (Level V and VI) may also be allowed to take selected undergraduate courses. |
| Program Duration | The period of study is one year. However, those who fulfill certain conditions will be permitted to extend their period of study for up to one additional year. |
| Completion Requirements | A certificate of completion will be issued to students who meet the following requirements: 1) Completion of two semesters of study 2) Earning a minimum of 32 credits with at least 16 credits earned each semester |
| Capacity | 30 students (including exchange students) |

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| Application Requirements | 1. The applicant must have completed 12 years of formal education and be eligible to enter university, or the equivalent. 2. The applicant must have achieved grades of at least 75 points on 100 point scale, or 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale, at their last educational institution. |

| Application Period | March 15, 2026 (Sun) 10 AM - April 15, 2026 (Wed) 5 PM (JST) |
| Selection Criteria | Admission decision will be made on the basis of the applicant’s submitted documents. However, when necessary, we may arrange an interview including an online interview. |
| Study Abroad Period | Fall semester : September to January Spring semester : April to August |
| Selection Result | Within six weeks after the application deadline. Results will be sent by e-mail. Inquiries regarding acceptance or rejection will not be answered. |
| Notes | Applications will only be accepted if all required documents and the application fee payment are completed by the deadline. Applications cannot be submitted at the university office. |

| Important Notices | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students who cannot stay until the end of the program and miss the final exams will not receive credits or certificates. • Living Expenses: Sufficient funds are required to obtain a residence permit (see Proof of Financial Support). Submit a bank statement in your or your family’s name to demonstrate the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * 1-semester program: Equivalent to ¥500,000 * 2-semester program: Equivalent to ¥1,000,000 • Applications are screened by the admissions committee for the programs. Admission to Aichi Shukutoku University is confirmed only upon receipt of the official Letter of Admission. Applicants are advised not to purchase airline tickets prior to receiving this letter. • Regardless of VISA or residence permit validity, students are required to return home immediately after completing their studies (upon finishing the final exams) in accordance with Japanese immigration law, and within the designated period, which will be notified after the admission letter is issued. • Students with pre-existing medical conditions are advised to verify with the Japanese Embassy or Consulate whether suitable medical facilities are available near the university (Nagoya/Nagakute area), as medical services in foreign languages are limited in Japan. All pre-existing medical conditions need to be disclosed at the time of application. • International students must have valid study-abroad insurance from their home country for the entire period of stay in Japan and, after enrollment, are required to join the insurance designated by ASU, including Gakkensai and the National Health Insurance. | |

2) Tuition and other fees


